The Elixir Extracts Festival is a weekend celebrating dance by older adults.

We are inviting dance groups for older adults from across the country to come to Sadler's Wells and show off what they do!

We aspire to present inclusive work which reflects the audience we serve. We welcome applications from any dance groups working with older adults (60+), from any dance style, of any background, from across the country, and are particularly interested in hearing from groups that represent the BAME community. (BAME definition - Black, Asian, and minority ethnic.)

Work submitted for the festival should be;

- 5 - 8 minutes in length (though if you have a shorter piece, we are still happy to hear from you!)
- Either a performance piece or if your group is not a performance group; a demonstration of how you usually dance together, which could work in front of an audience
- Must be performed by dancers over the age of 60.

Chosen work will be programmed into one of two performances alongside other groups on either **Saturday 15 or Sunday 16 June 2019** in the Lilian Baylis Studio, Sadler's Wells.

The deadline for applications is **Wednesday 19th December 2018 at midday**, with successful groups being notified by Friday 18th January 2019.
