The deep, speckled blue of lapis lazuli was the base for the most precious and expensive of colours in the Renaissance painter's palette, providing the clear sky blue so familiar in the paintings of Leonardo da Vinci.

During lockdown, the team was drawn to the open clarity of sky, wind-shaped landscapes, and birdsong, without the distractions of normal everyday living. These are the inspiration and backdrop to this outward looking, hopeful and regenerative ballet.
